


 - Declination decreasing, Equinox September 22, Solstice December 21
- Mercury
 - Superior conjunction was on August 17
 - In evening sky, greatest eastern elongation October 1 (26°)
 - Today, rise 09:25, transit 14:15, set 19:05
- Venus
 - In morning sky, greatest western elongation August 13 (46°)
 - Today, rise 02:55, transit 10:10, set 17:25

Earth

- Time
 - 00:00UT ≈ 00:30ST today
 - BST ends 02:00 Sunday 25 October
 - Today, sunrise 06:55, transit 12:45, sunset 18:40 (BST)
 - End of period, sunrise 06:40, transit 11:35, sunset 16:35 (UT)
- Moon
 - Full, 01 (Harvest Moon)
 - \$\mathbb{\text{\text{\text{\text{Quarter, 10}}}}\$
 - New, 16
 - First Quarter, 23
- Meteors
 - only sporadic activity this period

- Uranus
 - Opposition October 31. Today, rise 19:30, transit 03:00, set 10:15
- Neptune
 - Opposition September 11. Today, rise 18:10, transit 23:45, set 05:25
