



# Inner Solar System


- Sun
  - Declination increasing, solstice Jun. 20, aphelion Jul. 5
  - Last sunspot min., Apr. 2020, next max., early-mid 2024?
- Mercury
  - In evening sky, current elongation  $18^\circ$ , mag 0.0
  - Inferior conjunction (nearside of Sun), Apr. 11
  - Then in the morning sky, greatest elongation May 9 ( $26^\circ$ )
  - Today, rise 06:00, transit 13:00, set 20:05
  - “Good observing” opportunity just now
- Venus
  - In morning sky, and currently  $18^\circ$
  - Superior conjunction, Jun. 04
  - today, rise 05:25, transit 10:50, set 16:20

# Earth

- Time
  - 00:00UT ≈ 12:10ST today
  - Today, sunrise 05:45, transit 12:00, sunset 18:15
  - End of period, sunrise 05:40, transit 12:50, sunset 20:05
  - BST starts, 01:00 Mar. 31
- Moon
  -  Last Quarter, Apr. 02
  -  New, Apr. 08 + eclipse
  -  First Quarter, Apr. 15
  -  Full, Apr. 23 ('Seed or Egg' Moon)
- Meteors
  - None of note this period

# Eclipse

- Total Solar
  - Apr. 8
  - not visible from UK
  - maximum duration 4<sup>m</sup> 28<sup>s</sup>




# Outer Solar System

- Mars
  - Conjunction 2023 Nov. 18. Opposition 2025 Jan. 16. Today, rise 05:00, transit 09:55, set 15:00
- Jupiter
  - Conjunction May 18. Opposition Dec. 07. Today, rise 07:00, transit 14:30, set 22:00
- Saturn
  - Conjunction Feb. 28. Opposition Sept. 08. Today, rise 05:15, transit 10:35, set 16:00
- Uranus
  - Conjunction May 13. Opposition Nov. 17. Today, rise 07:10, transit 14:50, set 22:30
- Neptune
  - Conjunction Mar. 17. Opposition Sept. 21. Today, rise 05:40, transit 11:30, set 17:20

# Comet

- 12P/Pons-Brooks
  - Currently low in the West after sunset
  - Perihelion, Apr. 21
  - Perigee, Jun. 2, mag. 4.5?
