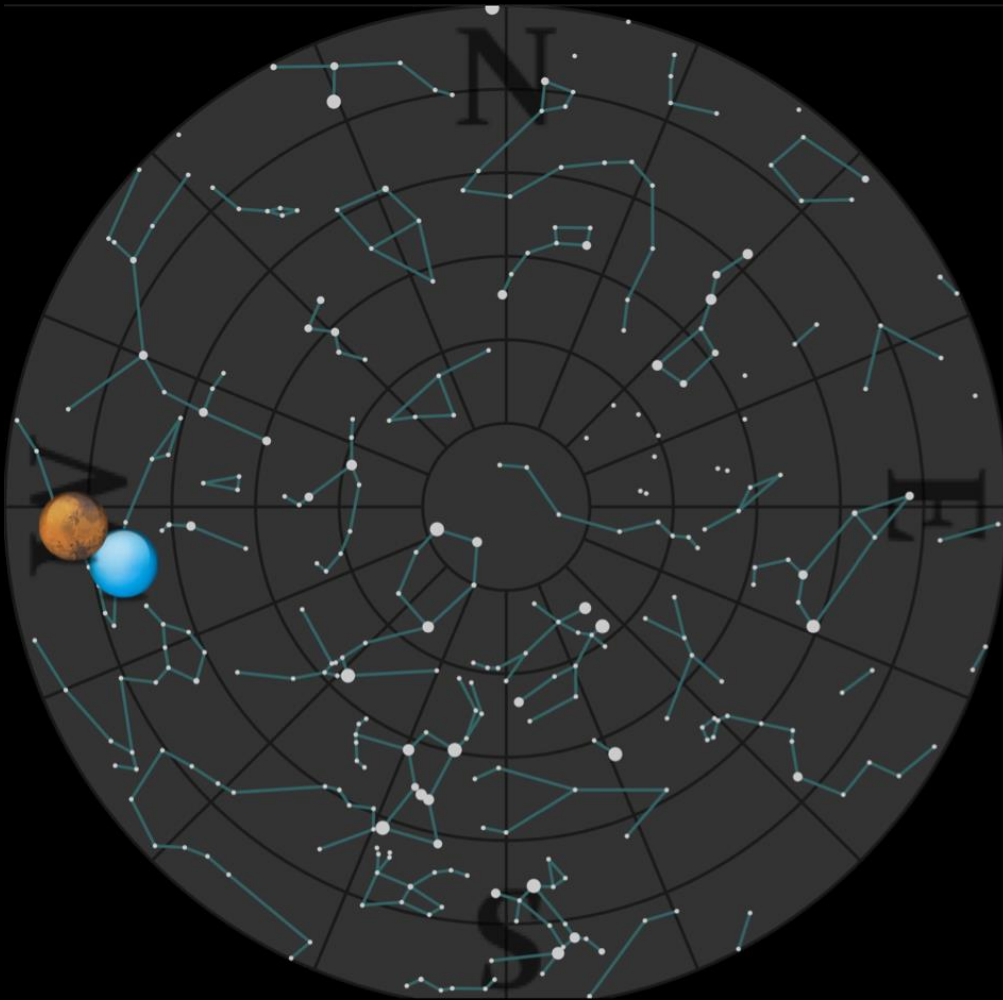

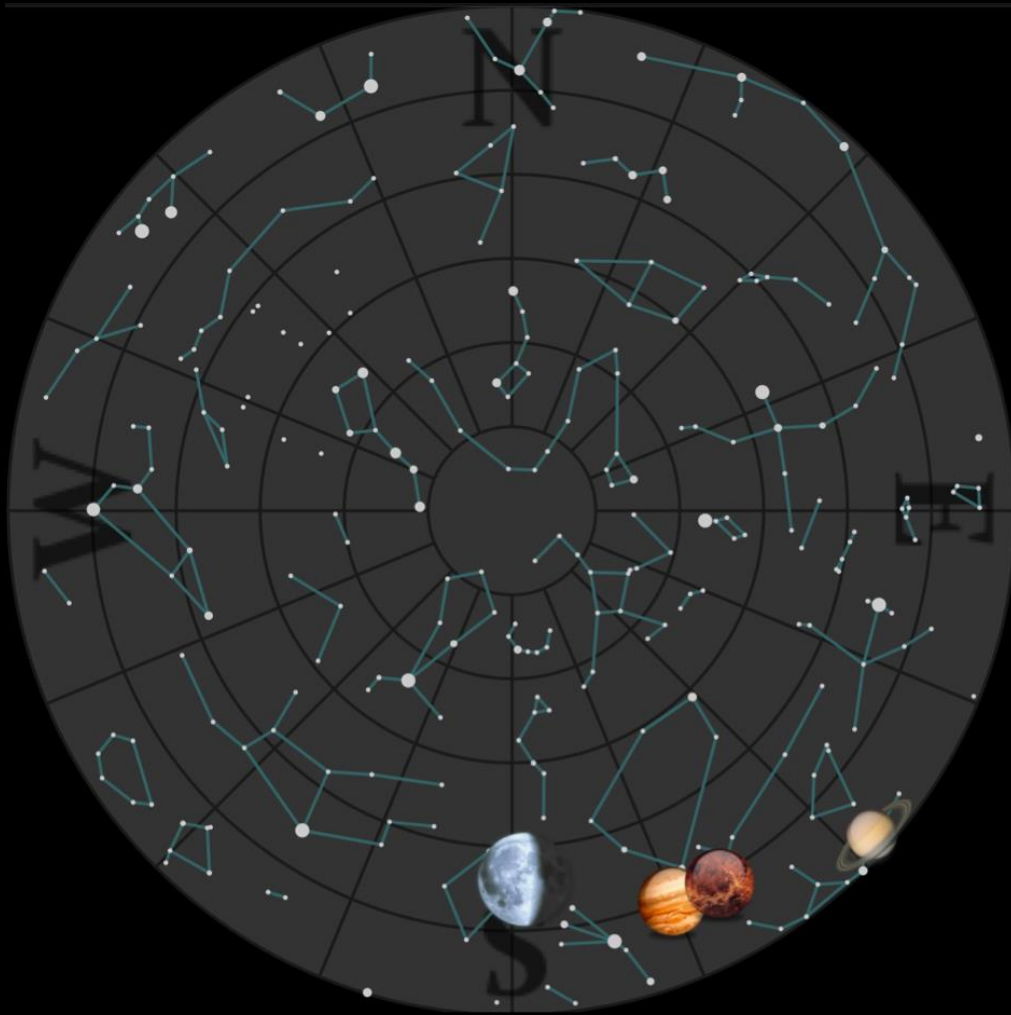

Inner Solar System

- Sun
 - Declination increasing
 - Equinox March 20
- Mercury
 - Superior conjunction January 30
 - Then in the evening sky, greatest elongation February 27 (18°)
 - Inferior conjunction March 15
 - currently rising 07:48, setting 15:30
- Venus
 - In morning sky until superior conjunction on August 14
 - Greatest elongation January 06 (47°)
 - Currently rising 04:30, setting 13:15

Earth

- Time
 - 00:00UT \approx 08:28ST today
 - Today sunrise 07:42, sunset 16:35
 - End of period sunrise 06:50, sunset 17:25
- Moon
 -  New, February 04
 -  First Quarter, 12
 -  Full, 19 (hunger moon)
 -  Last Quarter, 26
- Meteors
 - Only sporadic activity this month

Lunar Occultations

- February 02
 - Moonrise 06:12 (127°)
 - 06:32 Saturn RD
 - Sunrise 07:34

Outer Solar System

- Mars
 - Currently rising 10:30, setting 23:20. Solar Conjunction September 02
- Jupiter
 - Currently rising 05:10, setting 13:15. Opposition on June 10
- Saturn
 - Currently rising 07:14, setting 15:15. Opposition on July 9
- Uranus
 - Currently rising 11:00, setting 01:00. Opposition on October 28
- Neptune
 - Currently rising 09:55, setting 20:50. Opposition on September 10
